Who We Are

Communitas is a charitable, faith-based organization providing care in communities across British Columbia to those living with disabilities. As a part of our mission, we provide services ranging from 24-hour residential care to skills-based day programs to respite care for families. At Communitas, we support and empower people of all abilities, from all walks of life, faith, social standing, race or ethnicity.

We began in 1974 and celebrated 50 years of service in 2024.

In the beginning days, a group of parents asked "Who will care for our children?" and Communitas responded to these families in those early days. We began at the forefront of a movement of deinstitutionalization, establishing group homes to care for adults with developmental disabilities, then adding support services to support people with life skills as well as social, recreational and vocational skills.

In the 1990s, Communitas expanded its services to include people living with mental illnesses and the work of the organization grew geographically, supporting people on Vancouver Island and the Okanagan.

Today, Communitas employs approximately 435 staff providing personcentred care for more than 1000 people.

Whether it is a shared living home or a daytime activity program, whether a person is living with a developmental disability or someone is journeying with mental health challenges or an acquired brain injury, all who come to Communitas are treated with respect, dignity and love.
